THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF DEFENCE (SHRI SHIVRAJ V. PATIL): Yes, Sir. But the detailg cannot be given in the public interest.

## Shifting of Naval Academy from Cochin

The Government had appointed a Committee of Naval experts to give its recommendation regarding the most suitable sites for the permanent location of the Naval Academy. The report submitted by this Committee is under consideration.
