

**MOTION FOR ELECTION TO THE COUNCIL OF THE INDIAN
INSTITUTE OF SCIENCE, BANGALORE**

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI KAPIL SIBAL): Sir, I move the following Motion:—
