MR. CHAIRMAN: Hon. Members, I refer with profound sorrow to the passing away of Shri K. Gopalan, a former Member and Shri Vasant Chavan, a sitting Member of this House.

Shri K. Gopalan passed away on the 9<sup>th</sup> June, 2006, at the age of 87 years. Born at Calicut in Kerala in December, 1919, Shri Gopalan had his education at Malabar Christian College, Calicut and St. Thomas College, Triohur.
