run the institute. Central Government may provide Viability Gap Funding (VGF). The State of Orissa will definitely get its due share; and

2. A separate Centrally Sponsored Scheme is being formulated by this Ministry for skill development of youth in 33 identified districts affected by Left Wing Extremism. This will include five districts (Deogarh, Gajapathi, Malkangiri, Sambalpur and Rayagada) of Orissa. The scheme envisages setting up of ITIs and Skill Development Centres (SDCs) at block level".

Both the schemes are under consideration of the Government.

Probe into dumping of items by China

*357.SHRIMATI SHOBHANA BHARTIA: Will the Minister of COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has initiated a probe into the alleged dumping of several items by China after finding "sufficient evidence" of injury to the domestic players;
- (b) if so, details of the dumping of items came to the notice of the Government in the past one year;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to take stringent steps to check such dumping by China which is directly affecting domestic industry; and
 - (d) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY (SHRI ANAND SHARMA): (a) Yes, Sir.

- (b) Eleven (11) anti dumping investigations concerning imports of Coumarin, Synchronous Digital Hierarchy (SDH) transmission equipment, Barium Carbonate, Circular Weaving Machines, 1,1,1,2-Tetrafluoroethane or R-134a of all types, Glass Fibre and articles thereof, PVC Paste Resin, PVC Flex Films, Pencillin-G Potassium; and 6-APA, Sodium Tripoly Phosphate, Seamless Tubes, from China PR have been initiated by the Directorate General of Anti Dumping and Allied Duties (DGAD) in 2009-10.
- (c) and (d) Anti dumping investigations are conducted by DGAD as per the procedure prescribed in the Anti Dumping Rules and findings recommending the amount of anti dumping duties to remove injury to the domestic industry are submitted to the Central Government Acting upon the recommendations of DGAD, the Central Government has levied definitive anti dumping duties on 12 cases during the financial year 2009-10 on imports of Cable Ties, Cathode Ray Television Picture

Tubes - II, Compact fluorescent lamps (CFL), Plain Medium Density Fibre Board, All Fully Drawn or Fully Oriented Yarn/Spin Draw Yarn/Flat Yarn of Polyester (FDY), Ceramic tiles, Flax Fabrics, Tyres Curing Presses, Carbon Black, Radial Tyres, Cold Rolled Products of Stainless Steel, Classified Plastic Processing Machinery and provisional anti-dumping duties on 8 cases on imports of Coumarin, Synchronous Digital Hierarchy (SDH) transmission equipment, Barium Carbonate, Circular Weaving Machines, 1,1,1,2-Tetrafluoroethane or R-134a of all types, Glass Fibre and articles thereof, PVC Paste Resin, PVC Flex Films from China PR.

Differences between CRPF and Chhattisgarh Police

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI AJAY MAKEN): (a) to (c) The deployment and operational strategy of security forces for anti-naxal operation in Chhattisgarh is jointly reviewed by the State Police and the CRPF periodically. Differences if any are resolved through mutual discussion. Consolidation/relocation of force is decided keeping in view operational requirements.
