RE. DEMAND FOR LAYING ON THE TABLE OF THE HOUSE THE INQUIRY REPORT ABOUT THE DEATH OF SHRI ASHUTOSH KAUSHIK

SHRI BHUPESH GUPTA (West Bengal): Sir, we wanted the Government to lay on the Table of the House the Inquiry Report about the death of Ashutosh Kaushik, a student of Kashmiri Gate Polytechnic, Delhi. According to our information, the report is with the Government. The inquiry was conducted by Mr. S. C. Jain, Sessions Judge. I do not know as to why the report is not made available to us. Sir, we are entitled to have it. You know, Sir, that some suicide cases were discussed in this House or mentioned by some Members. According to our information the report is not made available to us because Lt. Gen. Bawa, Mrs. Sheila Chandra, Director of Technical Education and the Ministry of Education have come in for adverse comment in regard to this suicide case. Therefore, we want the matter to be placed before the House in this session. We should have discussion on it. We are entitled to it. It is our privilege. I find that there is no reference to the report.
