THE MINISTER OF FINANCE (SHRI R. VENKATARAMAN): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) Government have decided to constitute a separate Banking Service Recruitment Board for the North-Eastern Region. The proposed Board would be the recruiting agency for the officers' cadre of United Bank of India, on all-India basis and for the clerical cadre of all nationalised banks in the States and Union Territories of North-Eastern Region, namely, Assam, Manipur, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Tripura, Mizoram and Arunachal Pradesh.
