**Allotment of Land to Patel Education Society, Delhi**

Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Spring-dales Schools sponsored by Society named 'Patel Education Society', Delhi is registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1960 as a non-profit sharing society and membership of the Society are open to any individual;

(b) whether it is a fact that on the recommendations of his Ministry 'Patel Education Society' was allotted prestigious land at Pusa Road and Hauz Khas at the rate of Rs. 5,000 per acre, if so, what are the details in this regard;

(c) what is the total receipt/income of the Society and expenditure (head-wise) during the last three years and what is the total assets of the Society, category-wise;

(d) what are the names and addresses of the present management and other members alongwith their designation and since when they were elected and whether they continue in office as per its bye-laws; and

(e) whether these members are receiving remuneration, if so, under what provision of the Act they get remuneration?

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION AND HEALTH AND SOCIAL WELFARE (SHRI B. SHANKARANAND): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The Society was allotted 1.80 acres for school purposes and 2.34 acres for playground in Pusa Road, and 4.92 acres in Dhola Kuan area for school building in 1961 and 1978 respectively at a premium of Rs. 5,000/- per acre and 5 per cent thereof as annual ground rent for school purposes, and only an annual licence fee of Re. 1/- per acre for playground purposes. No land has ! been allotted at Hauz Khas.
