## Providing drinking water facilities in **Kumaon region**

876. SHRI KRISHNA NAND JOSH I: Will the Minister of WORKS AND HOUSING be pleased to state; what are the details of the steps Central

Government have taken so far or propose to take to provide drinking water facilities to the people of the Kumaon region in Uttar Pradesh during the current financial year?,

THE MINISTER OF WORKS AND HOUSING- (SHRI P. C. SETHI): Provision of drinking water supply is a State subject. The priority to the schemes of a particular region is determined by the State Government for which funds are provided in the State sector under the Minimum Needs Programme. The Central Government is, however, assisting the various States including the State of U.P. by provid. ing grants-in-aid to cover identified problem villages for which schemes are forwarded by the States and technically cleared by the Ministry. So far under the Accelerated Rural Water Supply Programme the following number of schemes have been approved in 3 districts of Kumaon region:
