THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI YOGENDRA MAKWANA): (a) No, Sir.

(b) The top posts are filled by senior Indian Police Service Officers and others taken on deputation from the various States, after examining their suitability.

(c) No, Sir. However, normal rotation of officers between the Centre and the States is a continuing process.

(b) and (c) A delegation of women Members of Parliament and representatives of women's Organisations called on the Prime Minister on 18-7-80 and presented a memorandum dated 17-7-80 signed by a number of women Members of Parliament and other women regarding the recent incident in Baghpat and the behaviour of the police against women in general.
