- (c) The following measures are being taken to prevent such incidents in Bombay area:
  - 1. Armed escorting of night passenger trains is being done by Government Railway Police.
  - 2. A squad of one Sub-Inspector and 20 other ranks has been raised in the Government Railway Police for carrying out raids and apprehend criminals operating on trains in Bombay.
  - 3. The escorting parties have been instructed to particularly ensure security of lady passengers.
  - 4. Special watch is being kept by the Police on crime prone areas particularly Vikhroli-Bhandup and Sion: and
  - 5. Frequent Nakabandi is done by the Police in Bombay area for arrest of criminals.
  - (d) Yes, even at the highest level.
- (e) A post of D.I.G. of police exclusively for Railways in Maharashtra and another post of Superintendent Of Railway Police for Bombay area are being created by Maharashtra Government so that better protection and security to railway passengers could be secured.

## Introduction of a new train from New Jalpaiguri to New Delhi

1090. SHRI LEONARD SOLOMAN SARING: Will the Minister of RAIL-WAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that, due to the unadjustiable timings of the Tinsukhia Mail Up and Down passing through the New Jalpaiguri Railway Station at 0020 Hours, the representatives of Sikkim, North Bengal Assam including Members of Parliament have submitted a memorandum to the Railway Minister for introducing a new train starting from New Jalpaiguri to New Delhi; and

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH (SHRI NIHAR RANJAN LASKAR); (a) One Unani Physician has been transferred from the Sarojini Nagar Dispensary to Lucknow.

(b) Yes, Sir. One Unani unit was sanctioned for Daryaganj on 20-10-78.
