- (ix) A detailed scheme may be worked out by Government of India regarding CAS legislation in three metro cities-Delhi, Mumbai and Kolkata in consultation with the concerned State Government.
- (x) Finally, it was decided that SIMCON will be held annually henceforth and official level interaction will be held twice a year.
