**Committee on working of state electricity boards**

1214. SHRI S. K. VAISHAMPAYAN: Will the Minister of ENERGY AND COAL be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Committee appointed to go into the working of State Electricity Boards has submitted its report to the Central Government; and

(b) if so, what are the main recommendations made by this Committee?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENERGY (SHRI VIKRAM MAHAJAN): (a) The report of the Rajadhyaksha Committee on Power, which is also going into the working of State Electricity Boards besides various other aspects of the power supply industry, is yet to be received by the Central Government. However, the Report is expected to be submitted to the Ministry of Energy (Department of Power) shortly.
