1462. SHRI K. K. MADHAVAN:
Will the Minister of INDUSTRY be
pleased to state:

(a) what is the number of posts in the Kalamassery Unit of the H.M.T. viz., Class I, Class II, Class III and Class IV, what is the number of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes separately in respective grades;

(b) what is the number of persons promoted in the said unit of H.M.T. during the year 1974—1979, and what is the number of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes employees promoted separately; and

(c) what steps Government have taken to maintain the quota of representation of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in the Unit?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN

(SHRI CHARANJIT CHANANA):

(a) HMT have reported the position as under:—

(b) HMT have furnished information for the period 1975—79 as under:—

(c) HMT have initiated a special drive to improve the quota of representation of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes. Special arrangements were made to locate suitable candidates belonging to the Scheduled Tribes in and around Kalamassery. Also, HMT introduced a "Trade Training Scheme" exclusively for SC/ST candidates so that after extensive training they could be absorbed in H.M.T. Simultaneously, for promotions as the criteria in case of eligible SC/ST employees has been relaxed.

1463. SHRI RAM BHAGAT PASWAN: Will the Minister of INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

(a) whether vacancies in the mills and offices owned by large houses like Birla, Tata, Singhanian are reserved for persons belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes as per Government rules;

(b) if so, what is the percentage of reservation allowed for Scheduled Castes by these large houses; and

(c) if answer to part (a) above be in the negative whether Government propose to issue a statutory order for making it obligatory for the large houses to make the necessary reservations?]

उद्योग मंत्रालय में राज्य मंत्री (श्री चरन्जीत चानना): (क) और (ख) निजी औद्योगिक क्षेत्र में अनुसूचित जाति व अनुसूचित जनजाति के प्रत्याशियों के लिए पदों के वैधानिक आरक्षण करना कानूनी दृष्टि से संभव नहीं है। किन्तु प्रशासनिक निर्देशों के अनुसार सरकारी क्षेत्र में ऐसा किया जाता है।

(a) and (b) Statutory reservation of posts for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes candidates in private industrial sector is not legally possible. In the public sector, this is, however, done by administrative directions.

Scarcity of bread

1464. SHRI SHIVA CHANDRA JHA: Will the Minister of INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that there is scarcity of bread in Delhi, Calcutta, Bombay and Madras;

(b) if so, what are the reasons therefor; and

(c) if not, what is the present daily demand and supply of bread in these cities vis-a-vis two months back?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRY (SHRI CHARANJIT CHANANA):

(a) According to information received from Delhi Administration and the Government of Maharashtra, there is some scarcity of bread in Delhi and Bombay. The Governments of West Bengal and Tamil Nadu have reported that there is no scarcity in Calcutta and Madras.

(b) The Government of Maharashtra has stated that scarcity of bread is due to fall in production of maida caused by closure of a flour mill as also due to lower quality of maida. The Delhi Administration has reported that the scarcity could be due to bread being moved out of Delhi to secure better prices; no specific cases have however, come to notice.

(c) The Government of West Bengal has reported the following position in respect of Calcutta:—

The Government of Tamil Nadu has stated that demand and supply figures are not readily available as
