THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRY (SHRI CHARANJIT CHANANA): (a) to (c) A cement factory with a capacity of four lakh tonnes per year is being constructed at Yerraguntla by the Cement Corporation of India, which is a public sector undertaking. The factory is expected to be completed by the end of the year. In addition a cement factory at Adilabad with an annual capacity of four lakh tonnes and another factory at Tandur with a capacity of one million tonnes per year have been approved for construction by the Cement Corporation of India.

Warriar, formerly Chairman-cum-Managing Director, BHEL is under consideration of Government. Presently the charge of Chairman-cum-Managing Director, Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited is being held by Secretary, Heavy Industry, in addition to his duties.

As regards MAMC, its earlier Chairman, Shri P. C. Luthar, who has now been appointed as Chairman of the Damodar Valley Corporation has been requested to continue to function as CMD, MAMC also till alternative arrangements are made.

(c) Appointment to the posts of Chief Executive of Public Sector Undertakings is made by Government after taking into consideration the seniority and merit of eligible officers.
