THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF TOURISM AND CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI CHANDU-LAL CHANDRAKAR); (a) Yes, Sir. Since none of the airports in the North Eastern Region (except Agarnight landing tala) has facilities. flights from the stations of this region for Calcutta have necessarily to takeoff well before night fall and the passengers are forced to wait for the late evening flight from Calcutta to Delhi. Besides Gauhati airport, the aerial gateway of the Region, closes to jet aircraft operation by 1130 hours due to works on the runway apron.
