ALI ASHRAF FATMI): (a) and (b) A request was received from the Madhya Pradesh Government for 100% Central support under Sarva Skiksha Abhiyan (SSA) or alternatively for changing the Centre-State funding pattern to 90:10 during the Tenth Plan and 85:15 pattern thereafter.

Training of Community organisation/members is part of the approvals given to Annual Work Plan & Budget (AWP&B) of Madhya Pradesh under SSA and funds allocated as per norms.

(c) and (d) Centre-State funding patterns are within the preview of the Planning Commission of India.
