

**Study tour of Tripura by a seven-member Committee headed by Shri Dinesn Singh, M.P.**

397. SHRI J. K. JAIN: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the seven-member Committee headed by Shri Dinesn Singh, M.P. has completed its study tour of Tripura; and

**Visit of military experts to U.S.S.R.**
