Revision of Jail manual for Tihar Jail

*65. SHRI S. KUMARAN: SHRI BHUPESH GUPTA: SHRI YOGENDRA SHARMA:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether any steps hav_e been taken for revising the jail manual for Tihar Jail. New Delhi; and

(b) if so, what are the details in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI YOGENDRA MAKWANA). (a) and (b) The Delhi Alministration have reported that in December, 1977, the Administration constituted а Committee consisting o'f 10 members (5 Members of the then Metropolitan Council and 5 officials) to suggest changes in the Punjab Jail Manual which is at present applicable to the Central Jail Tihar. The Committee submitted a Draft revised manual in February, 1980. This Draft, manual is under examination of the Administration.

Supply of enriched Uranium for Tarapur Atomic Power Plant

Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to $s^{tate:}$

(a) whether the U.S. President has recently written to the Prime Minister informing her that h_e has cleared the application for supply of nearly 40 tons of enriched uranium for the Tara, pur Atomic Power Plant;

(b) if so, by when the supply of enriched uranium is expected to reach India;

(c) how much uranium ha_s arrived in the country from the USA and how much is still awaited; and

(d) what assurance has been given to make uninterrupted supply of uranium till 1993 as per agreement with the USA?

THE PRIME MINISTER (SHRI-MATI INDIRA GANDHI): (a) The President of the United States of America has assured us of his intention to authorise the pending shipments of for the Tarapur enriches uranium Atomic Power Station by means of an Executive Order. President Carter has yet to take this action.

(b) Does not arise.

(c) The total quantity of enriched uranium received $sinc_e$ 1966 to date from the United States, inclusive of the initial inventory of the Tarapur Atomic Power Station, is 233.6 tonnes. Two export licence applications for 19.8 tonnes each of enriched uranium are pending with the U.S. authorities. The earlier application was made on September 20, 1978 for deliveries between March and August 1979. The later application was made on August 20, 1979, for deliveries between February and September 1980.

(d) The Government of India are in constant touch with the Government of the United States regarding the continued supply of enriched uranium on a regular and timely basis for the entire duration of the Cooperation Agreement in strict accordance with its provisions.

Central Development schemes

THE MINISTER OF PLANNING (SHRI NARAYAN DUTT TEWARI): (a) and (b) Government have no proposal at present to bring back centrally sponsored schemes which were transferred to the States by the previous Government. However, if it becomes necessary, the position will be reviewed i_n consultation with the National Development Council while formulating the Five Year Plan 1980-81 to 1984-85.
