for the M.G. line Chitradurg-Rayadurg has been included in the budget 1980-81. Commencement of construction of this line is also under consideration in consultation with Planning Commission.

Capitation Fees charged by Medical Colleges in Karnataka

768. SHRI MULKA GOVINDA REDDY: Will the Minister of HEALTH be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government are aware that the private medical colleges in Karnataka are charging capitation or a special tuition fee upto rupees one lakh and fifty thousand for admission in the medical colleges, disregarding Central Government's advice to stop collection of capitation fees; and
- (b) if so, what steps the Central Government propose to take to completely eradicate this practice?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH (SHRI NIHAR RANJAN LASKAR): (a) Yes.
