- (a) what is the number of applications pending for new telephone connections Dakshina Kamada District;
- (b) if so, what are the reasons for the delay in giv'ing connections; and
- (c) what steps are being taken to give connecions?

THE MINISTER OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI C. M. STEPHEN): (a) There are 2259 applications for telephone connectiong on the waiting list at present (31-5-80), in Dakshin Kar-nada (South Canara) district of Karnataka.

- (b) The department is not yet in a position to provide telephone connections on demand because of limited investable resources and switching equipment available.
- (c) The existing telephone exchanges are being expanded and new ones are being opened.

Problems of cocoa growers

ernment have nominated the Kerala State Cooperative Marketing Federation as the agency to purchase wet cocoa beans from individual farmers.

The Government of India have signed an agreement with the FAO for the services of an Expert to advise on the improvement of onfarm processing of cocoa beans, to enable cocoa grpwers to produce good quality beans,

- (d) whether there is any proposal under Government's consideration to construct a separate telephone exchange at Bhiwandi; and
- (e) what steps Government are taking to extend local service between Bombay and Bhiwandi as early as possible?

THE MINISTER OF COMMUNICA-TIONS (SHRI C. M. STEPHEN): (a) and (b) "No, Sir. The telephone service in Bhiwandi is not unsatisfactory. Some difficulty is however experienced due to heavy overhead alignments.

- (c) The overhead lines are being progressively replaced by undergrdfehd cables to reduce the incidence of faults.
- (d) Yes, Sir. A plot of land has been acquired and the construction of a building for the new exchange has been planned in the sixth Ave year plan.
- (e) There ig no such proposal under consideration.
