THE MINISTER OF LAW, JUSTICE AND COMPANY AFFAIRS (SHRI SHIV SHANKAR): (a) Complete particulars including names and locations of 1696 Wakf properties surveyed so far in the Union territory of Delhi have been notified in the Delhi Official Gazette from time to time.

(b) and (c) A number of such Wakf properties are in unauthorised occupation and the Delhi Wakf Board has been approaching the Civil courts for the eviction of such unauthorised occupants.

(d) No set rules for leasing out of Wakf properties have been laid down by the Delhi Wakf Board. Leases are granted by the Board keeping view the market value of the property, its location and the circumstantial merits of each case.
