Kosuire of small industries in Gujarat

285. PROF. PARIKH: RAMLAL Will the Minister of INDUSTRY be sleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that small industries in Gujarat have closed down due to shortage of pig iron and other raw material;
 - (b) if so, what are the details thereof; and
- (c) what remedial steps Government propose to take in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRY SHRI GEORGE FERNANDES): (a) and (b) Government are aware of the difficulties being faced by small in-iustries (including those in Gujarat) ising Pig Iron Steel, Coke Gov-:rnment have received representations from the associations and others in regard to the difficulties in procurenent of some of the above raw materials, to meet their full capacity re-juirement.

(c) Government have taken steps to augment the supplies of scare ,sategorie, of raw materials in the ferrous and non-ferrous categories through imports. Simultaneously, steps have been initiated by the State Government of Guj'arat to weed out ,he nonactual users of these raw naterials and to rationalise the supplies available to the genuine small cale units in the state'.
