(c) Government have taken steps to augment the supplies of scare categories of raw materials in terrous and non-ferrous categories Simultaneously, through imports. iteps have been initiated by the Slate Fovernment of Gujarat to weed out he non-actual users of these raw naterials and to rationalise the supolies available to the genuine small cale units in the state.
