THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRY (SHRI GEORGE FERNANDES): (a) The Central Government does not receive letters of intent licences from the State Governments. Presumably, the Hon. Member desires information about the applications for grant of letters of intentjindustrial licences received for the establishment of industries in West Bengal.

A total of 318 industrial licence applications for location of industries in West Bengal were received during the period 1.1.1976 to 30.6.1979. A statement showing detailg of items of manufacture to which these applications relate is enclosed.

- (b) 88 applications were rejected eut of the above.
- (c) As on 1-7-1979, fortysix appli-•atios in respect of West Bengal were pending and are at various stages of •onsideration.

315. SHRI PANDURANG DHAR-MAJI JADHAV: Will the Minister of INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government have filled up the vacancies reserved for

Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in the public sector undertakings under his Ministry;

- (b) whether the backlog of such vacancies in these undertakings has been cleared and if not, what are the difficulties in maintaining the percentage of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes; and
- (c) what steps Govt, propose to take in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRY (SHRI GEORGE FERNANDES): (a) The percentage of scheduled caste employees in the public sector undertakings under the Department of Industrial Development is 18.28 and in the Department of Heavy Industry, the figure is 11.4 per cent. The position regarding the scheduled tribe employees is 2.02 per cent in the Deptt. of Industrial Development 4.1 per cent in the Deptt. of Heavy Industry. Some vacancies reserved for these categories ar» yet to be filled up.

- (b) The entire backlog of vacancies reserved for scheduled castes and scheduled tribes in the public sector undertakings under this Ministry could not be cleared so far due to the non-availability of suitable personnel belonging to these communities, even after allowing maximum relaxation permitted under the Presidential Directives on this subject.
- (c) The various step₃ being taken by the Government in this regard art as follows:-
 - (i) The progress of SC|ST recruitment is closely monitored on quarterly basis.
 - (ii) Advertisements[notifications] requisitions for posts issued by the public sector undertakings are scrutinised and any deficiency in these advertisements etc., in so far as it relates to recruitment of

SC and ST, i_s brought to the notice of the Public Sector Undertakings.

- (iii) The Public Sector Undertakings were requested to depute a team of officers to visit the different institutions offering degree courses, diploma courses and industrial training institutes, so that SC1ST candidates who might be under going the final year of course are spotted and taken on the rolls of the public sector undertakings and thus helping them to reduce the backlog of unfilled reserved vacancies.
- (iv) Public Sector Undertakings have positioned a number of apprentices under the Apprentices Act. Publi Sector Undertakings have been requested to absorb all the SCjST apprentices after th« successful completion of their training to cover trie shortfall of SC|ST.
- (v) The inspection reports from Public Sector Undertakings are obtained and the shortcomings in the implementation of the Presidential Di rectives are being closelj watched.
- (vi) The verification of rosters and other relevant papers|docu-ments recruitment of SC/ ST i₃ conducted.
