Postal Division in Madhubani district

106. SHRI SHIVA CHANDRA JHA: Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Madhubani District in Bihar fulfils all the requirements for having a postal division of its own;

(b) if so, what are the reasons for which postal division has not been set up in Madhubani; and

(c) what specific requirements still need to be fulfilled by Madhubani for being a fulfilled postal division?

THE MINISTER OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI C. M. STEPHEN):

(a) to (c) New Postal Divisions are created by bifurcation of existing Postal Division in accordance with the norms approved by the Department. As per these norms, a Postal Division qualifies for bifurcation when the aggregate work load exceeds 2.9 points. As the work-load of Darbhanga Postal Division which at present also serves Madhubani District is less than 2.9, its bifurcation is not found to be justified. As and when the work-load of the parent division exceeds 2.9 points, the question of bifurcation and subsequent creation of Madhubani Postal Division will be considered.

Medicines produced in India
