prove the existing telephone services *in* the country?

THE MINISTER OF COMMUNI-CATIONS (SHRI C. M. STEPHEN): (a) No, Sir. There is no sharp and continuing decline in telephone services throughout the country.

(b) While there is no sharp decline as suggested above, the department is taking $step_s$ for improvement of services. The major steps are:

1. Installation of new exchanges and expansion of existing exchanges to meet the telephone demand.

2. Modernisation of telephone system_s by introduction of new types of exchanges, long distance equipment, underground cable practices $a^n d$ telephone sets.

3. Improvement of training of staff.

4. Bringing the field managers closer to the subscribers by decentralisation.

THE MINISTER OF COMMUNI-CATIONS (SHRI C. M. STEPHEN): (a) and (b) Thf needs of modernisation are kept in view on a continuing basis in the planning and implementation of various types of development schemes for the tele—communication

system. New methods and technologies have been and will be introduced te the extent they are practicable, useful and economically viable. Highlight of major steps towards modernisation which are at various stages of planning and implementation are aa follows:—

(1) Introduction of electronic switching systems for local, trunk and telex exchanges;

(2) Introduction of cable ducting and Pressurisation, jelly filled cables and junction working with pulse code modulation on junction cables and microwave radio in the local telephone network_s of major telephone districts;

(3) Progressive expansion of the long distance transmission and switching network to enable extension of subscribers trunk dialling facilities:

(4) Introduction of Satelite communications long the in distance network supplement to terrestrial facilities and to provide reliable communications to remote and inaccessible areas; and

(5) Trial installation of containerised small automatic exchanges and multi access radio links for improvement of telecommunication facilities in the rural areas.
