- (v) Placement of more light diesel oil at Kandla for being moved to States which are major consumers of this product.
- (vi) Advising the State Governments to give top priority to the agricultural requirements of diesel and to ensure adequate availability of diesel and kerosene
- (vii) Advising the State Governments to regulate the distribution of diesel and kerosene under the Essential Commodities Act and the rules and orders framed thereunder, as also to invoke the provisions of the Prevention of Blackmarketing and Maintenance of Supplies of Essential Commodities Act.
- (viii) Advising the oil companies to tighten up the supervision over their retail outlets.

THE MINISTER OF COMMUNICA-TIONS (SHRI C. M. STEPHEN): (a) Post Offices have been opened in most of the resettlement/newly developed colonies in Delhi. The resettlement/ newly developed colonies where post office has not yet been opened are 'H' and 'B' blocks of Jahangirpuri, Pitam. pura, Sarasvati Vihar, Nirman Vihar,

Yamuna Vihar, Vikaspuri, Satni Gagan Vihar and Preet Enclave, Vihar.

Post Offices will be opened in these colonies as and when they are justified according to the prescribed departmental norms. Constant review is being carried out by the Department in this regard.

(b) The names of resettlement/newly developed colonies where Public Call Offices have been provided is given in statement at Annexure I. PCOs resettlement/newly developed colonies at 'H' & 'B' Blocks of Jahangirpuri, Vikaspuri, Pitampura, Sarasvati Vihar, Nirman Vihar, Yamuna Vihar, Satni Enclave, Gagan Vihar and Preet Vihar will be opened soon as Post Offices are opened them.
