SHRI MOHAMMAD YUNUS SALEEM: It will create a bad precedent. If you waive it today, for the future it will be a very bad precedent and every time they will come to the Chair to waive the rule. There will be no end to it. Thefefore, I humbly submit...

MR. CHAIRMAN: Today the difficulty is that it has already been included in the agenda for the day's business. Therefore, obviously it must have been done with my consent, and the consent has been given to move it to-I think if we proceed with the business, we will be able to finish much more than if we enter into debates.
