While production in some industries is expected to be close to or in excess of the targets, the Fifth Plan targets in other industries have not been achieved.

(c) The Draft Five Year Plan for the period 1978—83 proposed targets only for 1982—83; year-wise targets within the plan period are being worked out. The question of any targets in the new plan not being reached does not arise.
