

(b) whether the pay of rank for the officers of Armed Forces has been increased with effect from January 1973 while the N.C.C. officers are not being paid pay of the corresponding rank; and

(c) if so, what are the reasons therefor?

THE DEPUTY PRIME MINISTER AND MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI JAGJIVAN RAM): (a) to (c) Part-time NCC officers of the Senior Division have ranks of 2nd Lieutenant, Lieutenant, Captain and Major as in the Army and equivalent ranks in the Navy and the Air Force. For the period of their attendance in the authorised training courses or camps, such officers are entitled to the same pay of rank as for corresponding ranks of the Armed Forces.

#### Rural Electrification Scheme for Rajasthan

515. SHRI KISHAN LAL SHARMA: Will the Minister of ENERGY be pleased to state;

(a) whether it is a fact that Rajasthan Government have submitted

schemes for rural electrification in Rajasthan for Central Government's approval;

(b) if so, what are the details in that regard; and

(c) what is the present progress in the implementation of the rural electrification schemes sanctioned previously for the State?

THE MINISTER OF ENERGY (SHRI P. RAMACHANDRAN): (a) As on 31st March, 1979, 32 rural electrification schemes involving a loan outlay of Rs. 15.44 crores submitted to Rural Electrification Corporation by the Rajasthan State Electricity Board for financial assistance were either under examination with the Corporation or referred back to the Rajasthan State Electricity Board for revision.

(b) The details of 32 schemes are shown in Statement enclosed. (See below)

(c) Upto 31st March, 1979 the Corporation had sanctioned 199 schemes of Rajasthan. Under these schemes 5,131 villages were electrified and 41,349 irrigation pumpsets were energised upto 31st December, 1978.
