Production of small scale industries and small units

777. SHRI CHADALAVADA VENKATARAO: Will the Minister of INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

(a) whether inadequate supply of power had resulted in decline in production of small scale industries and small units in the country during the year 1978-79;

(b) if so, what is the percentage of loss in production in these months during that period; and

(c) what steps Government have taken in the matter?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRY (SHRI JAGDAMBI PRASAD YADAV): (a) There is no formal system of reporting production in the small scale sector. All the small scale units are not registered with State Directorates of Industries as registration is voluntary. The small scale units do not supply production returns to the State Directorates of Industries. The small Industries Development Organisation, therefore, do not have production data unit by unit for the year 1978-79. There is no information about the number of units which use power and which do not use power. In view of this it is not possible to indicate the impact of inadequate power supply, on production in the small scale sector and further to indicate the actual loss in production during the year.
