WB aid for National Rural Health Mission

T. SUBBARAMI REDDY:

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government have approved launch of a National Rural Health Mission with Rs. 3,700 crores credit grants-in-aid from multilateral agencies;

(b) whether Government have also approved a proposal to initiate negotiations with World Bank for credit support of Rs 1575 crores and for grant-in-aid support for Department for International Development (DFID) for Rs. 2,125 crores for RCH-II programme to supplement resources of National Rural Health Mission; and

(c) if so, by what time final decision is likely to be taken and the areas to be covered during 2005-06?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRIMATI PANABAKA LAKSHMI): (a) and (b) Yes, Sir.

(c) The financial support of the World Bank and the DFID to the RCH programme is likely to be finalized within the first quarter of 2005-06 and it will cover the Reproductive and Child Health components of the programme which will be taken up for implementation in all the States and Union Territories of the country.
