Construction of Houses for Indians Residing in Foreign Countries

Government of India had requested the State Governments also to consider the desirability of drawing up similar schemes. Government of India has, however, no information about the number of State Governments which have drawn up such schemes.

THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND IRRIGATION (SHRI SURJIT SINGH BARNALA): (a) and (b) The targets of creation of additional irrigation potential during 1978-79 in the States of Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh and Rajasthan through major, medium and minor irrigation works are given below:—
