Demand for inquiry into the affairs of the Delhi Small Industries Development Corporation

Will the Minister of INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the employees of the Delhi Small Industries Development Corporation have demanded for an inquiry into the alleged mismanagement and misappropriation of the Corporation's finances; and

(b) if so, what action Government have taken or propose to take in the matter?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRY (SHRI JAGDAMBI PRASAD YADAV): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) Enquiries are in progress by the Central Bureau of Investigation, the Anti-corruption Department of Delhi Administration and the Vigilance Department of the Delhi Small Industries* Development Corporation into cases of alleged irregularities and mismanagement. Some of the enquiries have reached advanced stage. It has also been decided to set up a special cell comprising of Police officials and officers of the Delhi Administration to look into all cases in which the Corporation has suffered losses.

Losses incurred by Delhi Small Industries Development Corporation

Will the Minister of INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to the news report which appeared in the 'Hindustan Times' of the 12th January, 1979 to the effect that the Delhi Small Industries Development Corporation has been losing over rupees ten thousand a day at the Bhati mines:

(b) if so, what are the details thereof; and

(c) what steps Government have taken to save the Delhi Small Industries Development Corporation from further losses?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRY (SHRI JAGDAMBI PRASAD YADAV): (a) Yes, Sir. The Delhi Small Industries Development Corporation suffered revenue losses from 1st January, 1979 to 19th January, 1979.

(b) The reason for the losses was that some persons alleged to be members of a cooperative society un-

authorisedly entered the lease area operated by Delhi Small Industries Development Corporation and forcibly collected levy on sand and stones excavated from a part of the area during the period 1-1-79 to 19-1-79. The entire area was sealed by the competent authority on 20-1-1979. The competent authority lifted the seizure from half of the area on 8-2-79 and DSIDC is operating in this area since 9-2-79 after which the loss has been considerably reduced.

(c) Appropriate action under law has been taken by all concerned, namely the police, revenue authorities of Delhi Administration and the Corporation. Cases registered against the alleged trespassers are *sub judice*.
