THE MINISTER OF ENERGY (SHRI P. RAMACHANDRAN): (a) to (e) A statement is laid on the Table of the House.

Statement

(a) The following electrification scheme_s have been released for execution of work on the Pitampura Residential Scheme:

Poorvi Pitampura:

Electrification of pockets D, K&H (including street lighting). Uttri Pitampura:

Electrification of pockets K&H T&U (including street lighting).

Dakshni Pitampura:

Electrification of paqkete B^C.&G. (including street lighting).

It is reported by Delhi Electric Supply Undertaking that work in 'D' (Poorvi), 'U' (Uttri), 'C & 'G' (Dakshni) pockets for providing domestic & street lighting is in an advanced stage and electric connections are likely to be given in these pockets i'n about month's time.

(b) and (c) The scheme_s for electrification of pockets P&G, U&M (Poorvi) including street lighting are under finalisation. The scheme for electrification of 372 LIG flats in Pocket 'N' (Poorvi) have been finalised by Delhi Electric Supply Undertaking but Delhi Development Authority ha_s no scheme for immediate construction in this pocket so far

(d) No temporary arrangements have been provided by Delhi Electric Supply Undertaking.

(e) The electrification scheme of Pocket 'R' in Poorvi Pitampura is under finalisation by Delhi Electric Supply Undertaking. Work order will be issued on receipt of payments and fulfilment of commercial formalities after the demand note is sent by Delhi Electric Supply Undertaking on fina-lization of the scheme. 60

Proposal to raise the retirement age of Armymen

THE DEPUTY PRIME MINISTER AND MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI JAGJIVAN RAM): (a) and (b) Th_e period of colour service for Jawans was enhanced some time back. In vie_w of better health standard and increased longevity in the country, the three Chiefs have been asked to examine the possibility of further enhancing the colour service of Jawans and equivalent ranks in the Navy a'nd Air Force.

The age of retirement of Commissioned Officers in the Army was reviewed and raised in the year 1976. There i_s no proposal at present under consideration of the Government to raise their retirement age.
