Delay in the Publication of Telephone Directory for the year 1978

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI NARHARI PRASAD SUKHDEO SAI): (a) and (b) Hindi edition of 1978 issue of Delhi Telephone Directory has already been brought out for distribution from 5-2-79. 1978 issue of the English edition corrected upto 31-12-73 is already under print and will be published by the end of March 1978. There has been a slight delay in bringing out English edition of the directory as this is being compiled on the computerised process for the first time in Delhi Telephones.
