THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRY (KUMARI ABHA MAITI)- (a) The demand for passenger cars is met by indigenous production. Import of cars is largely confined to specialised type fitted with disability control to meet the specific requirements of disabled persons.

to Questions

In so far a commercial vehicles are concerned, the demand is met by domestic production. Special steps have been taken to augment the indigenous manufacturing capacity of commercial vehicles by about 40 per cent in this year in order to meet the increase in demand. The proposal of the Ministry of Shipping and Transport to import bus chassis, if so required, to supplement indigenous availability o,f chassis, has been cleared to the extent of 1500 numbers.
