## Derailment of Kollayam-bound passenger train at Perinad

(a) whether it is a fact that a Kottayambound passenger train from Quilon in Kerala went off the rails and overturned at Perinad on the 2nd February, 1979;

- (b) if so, what is the cause of the derailment; and
- (c) what is the number of persons killed/injured as a re ult thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI SHEO NARAIN): (a) Train No. 380 Up Quilon-Kottayain Passenger derailed between Quilon and Perinad stations on 2-2-1979.

- (b) The cause of the accident is under investigation by the Additional Commissioner of Railway Safety who is an independent statutory authority functioning under the administrative control of the Ministry of Tourism and Civil Aviation.
- (c) In thi<sub>s</sub> accident, 2 persons were killed, 8 sustained grievous injuries and 6 oimple injuries.
