Sports facilities in Tamil Nadu

4638. SHRI N.R. GOVINDRAJAR: Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

(a) the details of proposals regarding sports facilities in Tamil Nadu received during the last two years;

(b) the number out of them lying pending; and

(c) by when these proposals are likely to be cleared?

THE MINISTER OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS (SHRI SUNIL DUTT): (a) The details of proposals received from Tamil Nadu during the last two years (2003-04 to 2004-05) under the Schemes of "Grants for

Creation of Sports Infrastructure” and “Grants for Installation of Synthetic Playing Surfaces” for creation of sports facilities along their status have been given in the Statement (See below).

(b) The policy decision has been taken to transfer the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Sports Infrastructure to the State sector w.e.f. 1.4.2005. The State Government shall, henceforth, entirely fund the construction of sports facilities. In view thereof, no action is possible on the proposals which could not be considered till 31.3.2005.

(c) In view of (b) above, does not arise.

4639. SHRI N. R. GOVINDRAJAR: Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

(a) the details of the funds allocated for sporting events of Indian Origin (Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, etc.) during the last three years, State-wise;

(b) whether traditional sports of Indian origin are vanishing gradually as they are not given priority and encouragement;

(c) if so, the details thereof; and

(d) whether Government propose to provide opportunities to rural sports persons at national and international level by setting up village sports academy and providing them training and other facilities?

THE MINISTER OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS (SHRI SUNIL DUTT): (a) 'Sports' is a State subject and promotion of Sports at the State level is the responsibility of the concerned State Government. National Sports Federations are also responsible to promote sports at national and international level. However, Government during the last three years sanctioned Rs. 1.92 crores to recognized National Sports Federations dealing the discipline of Indian origin such as Atya Pattya, Carrom, Kabaddi and Kho-Kho. However, these funds are not allocated State-wise. Besides the sports tournaments are organized in the discipline of Kho-Kho and Kabaddi under the rural Sports Programme. The details of financial assistance released to different States/UTs for organizing competitions in Kabaddi and Kho-Kho at district and State level under Rural Sports Programme during the last three years is given in the Statement (See below).

(b) and (c) No, Sir. India won Gold Medals in Kabaddi in Asian Games, 1994, 1998 and 2002. Similarly India won a Gold Medal in Kabaddi in World Championship held in 2004.
