(c) The following steps- are being taken by Delhi Police to check incidents of eve-teasing-

(1) Increasing patrolling by uniformed and plain clothes men, at girls' schools/colleges, bus stops, cinema houses, shopping centres and parks.

(2) Detailing of plain clothes staff in buses.

(3) Strict watch over the activities of bad characters.

(4) Public can give information about eve-teasing on specified telephone numbers in all Districts to enable prompt action being taken.
