

Establishment of Netaji National Museum at Calcutta

Allotment of flats by DDA under the MIG Scheme

Will the Minister of WORKS AND HOUSING AND SUPPLY AND REHABILITATION be pleased to state:

(a) what is the number of flats, under the MIG scheme, released by the DDA in different localities in Delhi in March, 1978;

(b) what is the number of flats offered on hire-purchase and cash-down basis, separately in each colony;

(c) whether it is a fact that more flats have been released on hire-purchase basis, particularly in Janakpuri whereas those persons registered under MIG since 1971 are still awaiting allotment and the prices have shot

up more than two-fold since they got themselves registered;

(d) what steps Government are taking to allot flats to those persons who are on the waiting list for allotment in Janakpuri and what is the number of such persons in the cash-down and hire-purchase categories; and

(e) what is the number of persons who have been provisionally allotted flats in Janakpuri and what are the reasons for giving them priority over those on the waiting list?

THE MINISTER OF WORKS AND HOUSING AND SUPPLY AND REHABILITATION (SHRI SIKANDAR BAKHT): (a) 89 MIG flats were released as under:

Rajouri Garden	..	35
Wazirpur	..	20
Lawrence Road	..	25
Pankha Road	..	9

(b) The details are as under:

Name of the colony	No. of flats offered on C.D.	No. of flats offered on Hire purchase
1. Rajouri Garden .	18	17
2. Wazirpur . .	10	10
3. Lawrence Road .	13	12
4. Pankha Road .	4	5

(c) Nine flats were allotted in Janakpuri (Pankha Road). Four of these were allotted on cash down basis and five were allotted on hire purchase basis.

(d) 5 Persons are on the waiting list for allotment on cash down basis, while 3 are on the waiting list for allotment on hire purchase basis.
