THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI DHANIK LAL MANDAL): (a) to (c) On 2nd September, 1977 at about 6.15 P.M. six armed dacoits looted a shop in Sadar Bazar and while proceeding towards Chowk Baratooti in a Car had to slow down because of traffic obstruction. Meantime, some Police personnel on duty on hearing shouts stopped the car and apprehended on culprit who was having a dagger. The other five culprits escaped taking advantage of the crowd. Three Police personnel received injuries. Commendation Certificates Class (I) with Cash Award of Rs. 500 was given to each of the three injured Police personnel by the IGP, Delhi. No out of turn promotion has been given to the Constables.

Will the Minister of ENERGY be pleased to state by when work on the proposed Salal Dam is likely to start and by when the entire project is likely to be completed?

THE MINISTER OF ENERGY (SHRI P. RAMACHANDRAN): The Salal Hydro-electric Project which is under execution in J & K envisages, *inter alia* the construction of a Rock-fill Dam and a Concrete Dam on both of which work is in progress. As per present assessment, the first generating unit of 115 MW of the Project is ex-

pected to be commissioned towards the end of 1984 and the remaining two units of similar capacity in early 1985.
