An amount of Rs. 1 crore has been provided for in the budget proposals for 1978-79 for continuation of preliminary works.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI S. KUNDU): (a) No, Sir. No such suggestion was made to the Indian Embassy in Jeddah. It may be added that there are no local contractors but there are Mutawwifs (Pilgrims' Guides) who look after the pilgrims under Saudi Arabian Regulations which apply uniformly to all pilgrims from all over the world.

(b) The Government of India, in keeping with its firm and consistent policy of opposition to nuclear weapons and all other categories of weapons of mass destruction stand for the prohibition of the neutron bomb.
