THE MINISTER OF WORKS AND HOUSING AND SUPPLY AND REHABILITATION (SHRI SIKAN-DAR BAKHT): (a) and (b) The condition of the footpaths in Fero-zeshah Road is not satisfactory in spite of repairs, as they have been cut a number of times. They require reconstruction and this will be undertaken after the road is widened. The work is likely to be taken up and completed in the next financial year.

Targets fixed for sterilisation operations

276. SHRI S. W. DHABE: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) what is the number of sterilisation operations performed in the country during the period from the 1st April to the 31st December, 1977 and during the corresponding periods in the years 1975 and 1976; and

(b) what are the targets fixed for sterilisation operations for the year 1978?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI JAG-DAMBI PRASAD YADAV): (a) The required information is given below:

Year	Sterilisation operations
1977-78* (April, 1977—December 1977)	569,031
1976-77 (April, 1976—December, 1976)	7,080,045
1975-76 (April—Dec. 75)	1,374,201

*Figures provisional. The sterilisations performed were on an entirely voluntary basis.

(b) On account of wide-spread complaints of coercion received in connection with the sterilisation programme, it was decided that the word 'target' be changed to 'expected levels of achievement' and the word 'sterilisation' to 'Voluntary Sterilisation'. It was further decided that in 1977-78, the levels of expectation in respect of voluntary sterilisation be not insisted upon. For the year 1978-79, these levels of achievement have not yet been worked out.

Discrimination in regard to the fixation of cost of acquisition

(b) if so, what are the reasons for fixing only the cost of acquisition at Rs 12 per square yard for the allottees of the Chittaranjan Park as against Rs. 7.50 per square yard for both the cost of acquisition and the cost of development fixed in regard to land in
