Will the Minister of INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that there has not been much development of handloom and cottage industries in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands; and

(b) if so, what steps Government are taking to set up handloom and cottage industries in the small scale sector in these Islands?

THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRY (SHRI GEORGE FERNANDES): (a) and (b) Andaman & Nicobar Islands are rich in forest resources which provide great scope for development of forest resource-based handicrafts. The Andaman & Nicobar Islands Administration is seized of the need to develop handicrafts in these Islands. The Administration has proposed an outlay of Rs. 2.55 lakhs for the Annual Plan 1978-79.

There are no Commercial type of handlooms in Andaman and Nicobar Islands. The administration of Andaman and Nicobar Islands have not sent any proposals to Government of India for development of handloom industry.
