**Admission of students belonging to the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in schools & colleges in Delhi**

\*350. SHRIMATI RATHNABAI SREENIVASA RAO: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that students belonging to the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes seeking admission in colleges and schools under the control of the Delhi Administration are required to submit Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes certificates issued by the Delhi Administration as the caste certificates issued to their parents by other State Governments are not considered valid despite the fact that the caste indicated in their certificates are also recognised as Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes in the Union Territory of Delhi; and

(b) if so, what are the reasons therefor and what steps Government propose to take to correct the anomaly?

THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI CHARAN SINGH): (a) and (b) According to information supplied by the Delhi Administration, admission in schools is given to all Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe students on the basis of applications on the prescribed admission forms. The position regarding admission to colleges is, however, being ascertained.

**Artificial shortage of paper**

(a) whether it is a fact that the book publishers have accused the paper manufacturers for creating artificial shortage of paper by manipulating supplies and prices and have urged upon Government to take necessary steps in the matter; and

(b) if so, what action Government have taken to remedy the situation?

THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRY (SHRI GEORGE FERNANDES): (a) Representations have been received from publishers to the effect that paper manufacturers had increased prices of their products and that publishers are having difficulties in obtaining papers at reasonable prices for the production of books.

(b) Although there is no statutory control on the price of papers, Government have been discouraging the industry from resorting to unilateral increases in price without adequate justification, Government's unhappiness at the price increases effected by some mills without consulting Government, has been conveyed to the Paper Industry. The reaction of the industry is awaited before Government takes suitable regulatory measures to control the price situation. Steps are also being taken to increase the quantum of supply of concessional paper for the educational sector.
