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3. Government have launched the National Seeds Programme which aim⁸ at adequate and timely supply of seeds to farmers at reasonable prices through the net-work of sale counters and dealers at the village level.

III. FERTILISTERS:

1. Efforts were made to make available fertilisers to farmers at as reasonable a cost as possible by (a) reducing prices wherever possible; (b) providing subsidy to farmers; and ic) reduction of customs du ty /excise *levy* where possible.

2. Efforts were made to increase the number of retail outlets and storage points so that fertiliser became available to farmers nearer to the place of consumption.

3. To cope with unforeseen shortage of fertilisers due to failure of domestic production or sudden spurt in demand, a system of buffer-stocking was introduced.

Dwelling Units under construction hy the DDA

Pitcher Plant Facins Danger of Extinction

(ii) The natural habitats of this plant in Meghalaya, have been con-served and declared as 'Pitchar Plant Conservatories'.

(iii) Through publication and distribution of popular note on this plant by the Forest Department, Meghalaya Shillong, the public are being educa. ted to protect it.
