## Shortage of coal

- (a) whether Govern-ent are aware that many industrial units in the country are facing serious crisis due to acute shortage of coal;
- (b) if so, what are the reasons therefor; and
- (c) what steps Government have taken or propose to take to improve the coal supply in the country?

THE MINISTER OF ENERGY (SHRI P. RAMACHANDRAN): (a) and (b) There is no coal shortage in the country at present. Despatches of coal during the current financial year (April—February) have been approximately 4 million tonnes more than during the corresponding period last year and the stocks of coal at the pitheads as on 1-3-1978 are around 11.60 million tonnes showing an in. crease of about 2 million tonnes over the stocks of the previous two months.

(c) Whenever reports of low 3tocks at the consumer end are received, action *is* taken to step up despatches to the consumers concerned.
