Tourist traffic to Tripura

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM AND CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI PURUSHOTTAM KAUSHIK): (a) Since the Department of Tourism does not maintain tourist statistics on state-wise basis, no figure of visitors to Tripura during the last three years are available.

(d) Due to the existing entry restrictions on international tourists visiting the State, no tourism schemes have been taken up in Tripura in the Central Sector. However, in the State Annual Plan for 1978-79, a provision of Rs. 6 lakhs has been made towards the development of tourist facilities in Tripura.

Development of tea plantation industry in Tripura

(a) what is the capacity of the Boeing Aircraft operated on bi-weekly service between Calcutta and Port Blair and what is its daily average occupancy;

Cb) whether it is a fact that the airfield at Port Blair is not strong and large enough to enable the Boeing to take the full load of passengers; and

(c) if so, what steps Government are taking to develop the airfield?

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM AND CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI PURUSHOTTAM KAUSHIK): (a) The capacity offered on Boeing 737 bi-weekly service between Calcutta and Port Blair is about 100 seats each way. Its average occupancy is 55-60 passengers each way.

(to) The runway load bearing strength is not adequate for operation of Boeing 737 aircraft with full load. The use of full length of the runway and all weather bi-directional operations are not possible due to the hills in the approach of each end of the runway.

(c) The existing aerodrome can be developed only for visual uni-directional operations for Boeing-737. The comparative economics of developing the existing aerodrome and constructing a new aerodrome at an alternative site are being studied in view of the heavy investment involved in either case.
