Children in the age group of 1—8 years are susceptible to diptheria. Occasionally cases may occur in higher age groups and even among adults. The maximum incidence is seen in the age group 2—5 years. The disease may occur in seasonal outbreaks.

(b) The Government have sponsored a programme to immunize children against diptheria whooping cough and tetanus through the Department Welfare. Children below 5 years of age are immunized with triple vaccine which contains the antigens against diptheria, whooping cough and tetanus Older chldren are given only the bivalent vaccine against diptheria and tetanus as whooping cough is not a problem among age group. During the current year 18 million children were to receive the benefit of this immunization. It is proposed that larger number of children will be covered under the immunization in the coming years.

Besides a number of institutes in the private sector, there are two vaccine institutes in the public sector producing the vaccine. The Central Research institute Kasauli under the Government of India and the Haffkine Bio-Pharmaceutical Corporation of the State of Maharastra. Government of India are considering the setting up of an other institute to produce the vaccine.
